<p>Clothing appropriate for a family friendly environment.</p> <p>Clothing must be worn as intended to be worn.</p> <p>Shorts longer than mid thigh to knee length.</p> <p>Prescription glasses.</p> <p>Top and dresses that cover the chest, stomach and back. Cleavage must be appropriately covered so as not to cause offence.</p> <p>Religious headwear (e.g. Sikh turban, Jewish yamulkes, Muslim caps, Muslim women's headscarves, Rastafarian hats). Subject to searches as per HMP Wakefield's search policy.</p> <p>Clothing free of gang logos, racist slogans or any language which may be considered insulting or derogatory.</p>	<p>Hats, scarves or head coverings which are not worn on religious grounds</p> <p>Jackets or coats, hoodies or gloves.</p> <p>Inappropriately damaged clothing.</p> <p>Metal hair accessories.</p> <p>Steel toe-capped shoes/boots or cycle/motorcycle shoes.</p> <p>Non-prescription glasses i.e. sunglasses.</p> <p>See-through / revealing clothing.</p> <p>Ripped jeans.</p> <p>Items of clothing that display offensive, abusive or insulting words or gestures.</p> <p>Mini or very short skirts/dresses unless worn with leggings.</p> <p>Visible or exposed underwear</p> <p>Smart watches.</p>
